66/24	The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.	
67/24	There were no apologies.	
68/24	Declarations of interest were received from Cllr S Carlyon under item 13b Planning application PA24/02041 Retrospective application for the formation of parking spaces. Land To The Rear Of 3 And 4 Victoria Place Trevonnen Road Ponsanooth	
69A/24	A member of the public expressed concerns on the playing field path and asked questions regarding the project, members answered questions regarding the project and confirmed that the aim of the project is to improve the football pitch facility and access to play equipment.

74/24	PA24/01197 Cosawes Park - Ponsanooth Parish Council support the application but wish to raise concerns about surcharging, the Cornish hedge stability and dealing with surface water. They also would like to see no additional site lighting. It is disappointing the planning application was made after works, and that work is almost complete.	



	<p>They would like to bring attention to the planner that there are significant earth works outside of the planning permission area. It appears from the drawings that the land has been raised differently. There are Concerns about the stability of the Cornish Hedge, due to earth being to the height of the hedge. Drawings showed the package treatment plant, but doesn't show how it will get to the public sewer. Concerns were also raised about the level and the drainage issues this would cause. It is not clear if there is any lighting but recommend non to protect bats.</p>
